Examples include:

- Prompt collections
- Templates
- Worksheets
- Journals
- Educational guides
- Simple online courses

Unlike physical products, digital products can be sold repeatedly without keeping inventory.

Create it once.

Sell it many times.

## **Why AI Makes This Easier**

Years ago creating an eBook could take months.

Now AI can help you:

- brainstorm ideas

- organise chapters
- write first drafts
- improve grammar
- simplify language
- suggest titles
- create marketing copy
- answer customer questions

Remember:

AI is your assistant—not your replacement.

Always review everything before publishing.



## **Step 1 – Choose a Topic You Already Know**

Many retirees underestimate how much knowledge they have accumulated.

Ask yourself:

What do people often ask me?

Examples:

- Gardening
- Fishing
- Knitting
- Cooking
- DIY projects
- Bird watching
- Photography
- Budgeting
- Travel
- Home maintenance
- Family history
- Retirement planning
- Classic cars
- Woodworking
- Sewing

Knowledge that feels ordinary to you may be valuable to someone else.

## **Step 2 – Ask AI for Product Ideas**

Example prompt:

"Give me 20 simple digital product ideas based on gardening that beginners would buy."

AI might suggest:

- Vegetable planting calendar
- Seasonal gardening planner
- Pest identification guide
- Printable garden journal

- Herb growing guide
- Companion planting chart

Now you have products people may actually want.



### **Step 3 – Create an Outline**

Instead of staring at a blank page, ask AI:

"Create an outline for a beginner's guide to growing tomatoes."

Within seconds you'll receive:

Introduction

Choosing varieties

Preparing soil

Planting

Watering

Common pests

Harvesting

Frequently asked questions

Now the difficult part is already done.

## **Step 4 – Write One Section at a Time**

Never ask AI:

"Write my entire book."

Instead ask:

"Write a friendly 500-word introduction for beginner gardeners."

Review it.

Add your own experience.

Include personal tips.

Repeat for each chapter.

## **Step 5 – Add Your Personal Experience**

This is what makes your product unique.

Instead of:

"Water regularly."

Write:

"I've found that watering early in the morning during our hot summers produces healthier tomato plants."

AI cannot replace your real-life experience.



## **Step 6 – Create Supporting Resources**

People love practical extras.

Examples:

- Printable checklists
- Worksheets
- Monthly planners
- Calendars
- Templates
- Progress trackers
- Shopping lists

These increase the perceived value of your product.

## **Step 7 – Design the Product**

Free tools include:

- Canva
- Google Docs
- Microsoft Word

AI can even help design page layouts and suggest colour schemes.

Keep the design:

- clean
- readable
- uncluttered

## **Step 8 – Sell Your Product**

Popular platforms include:

- Your own website
- Etsy
- Gumroad
- Payhip

Start with one product.

Learn the process.

Improve over time.



## **Step 9 – Use AI for Marketing**

Ask AI:

"Write a Facebook post promoting my beginner gardening guide."

Or

"Write an email announcing my new printable planner."

Marketing becomes far less intimidating.

## **Realistic Income Expectations**

Some products may sell only a few copies.

Others may continue selling for years.

Success usually comes from creating:

- helpful products
- solving real problems
- building trust
- continually improving

Consistency matters far more than perfection.
